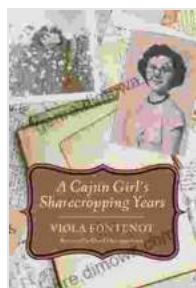

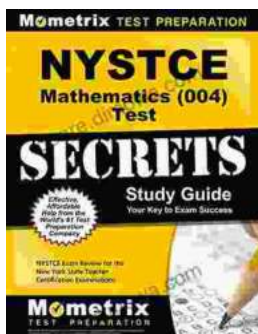
Fontenot passed away in 2016 at the age of 101. She is survived by her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

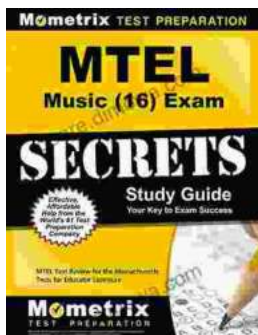
